Description of the James Prendergast Library Association Art Gallery

1. 118 linear feet of wall space
2. 864 square feet of floor space
3. No windows
4. Carpeting – gray
5. Incandescent track lighting – adjustable with filters; incandescent down flood lights
6. Beige Belgian linen covered $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch mahogany plywood walls. 4-foot-wide panels connected together,
7. Walls are 9'6" high in main gallery, 6'3" high in annex. Gray/blue walls above panels, off-white ceiling and trim
8. Passenger elevator to gallery 62" x 68" x 83" – door: 36" x 80"
9. Direct access from main reading room of James Prendergast Library (either by one flight of stairs or elevator)
10. Duplex electrical outlets, one foot above floor around entire room, one outlet in center of floor
11. Intrusion alarm system directly linked to Jamestown Police Department
12. Fire alarm system directly linked to Jamestown Fire Department
13. Gallery hours:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday	10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
Wednesdays	10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
Saturdays	10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

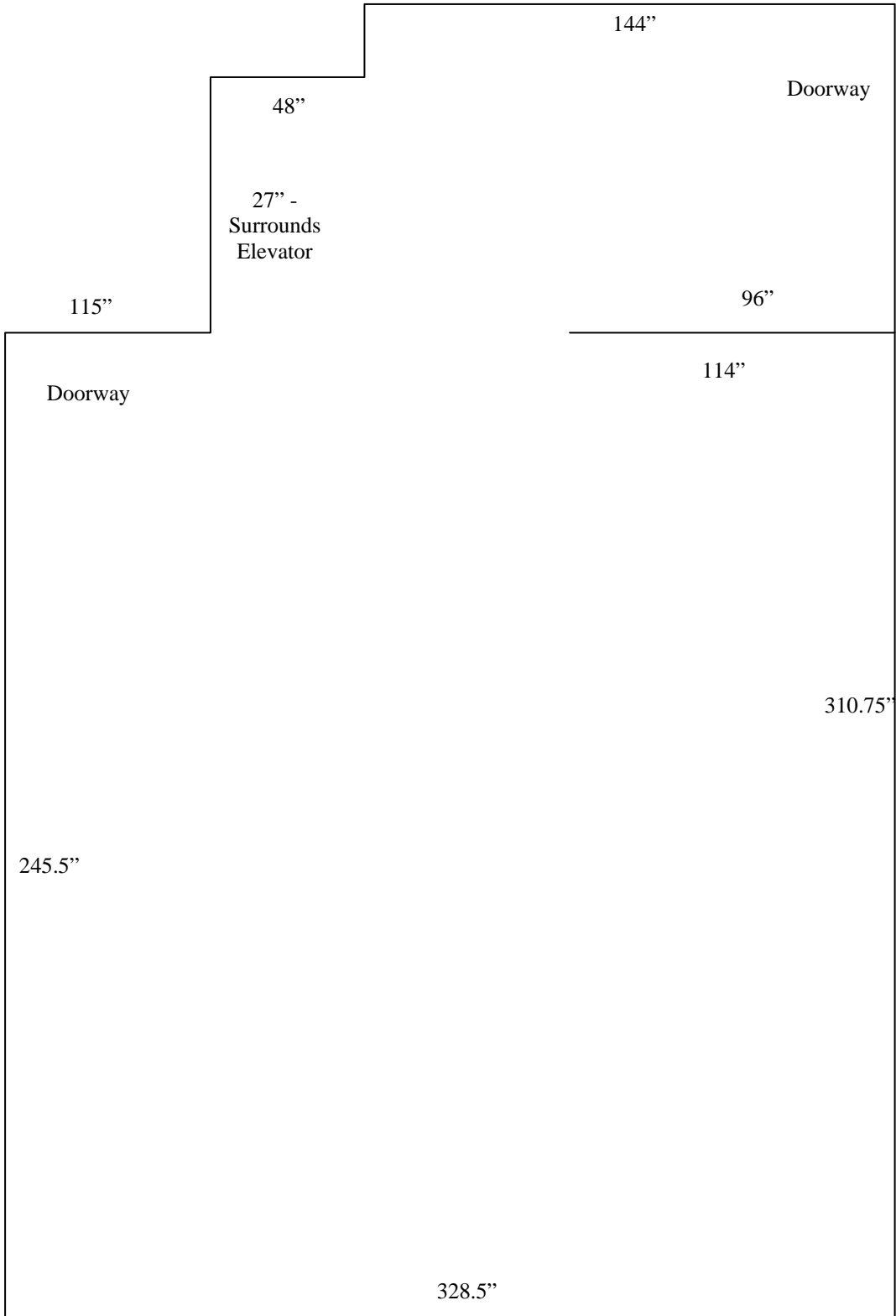


Exhibit Guidelines for the James Prendergast Library Association Art Gallery

- 1. Presentation of Work:** All work must be appropriately mounted and framed, ready to hang. The Gallery Coordinator reserves the right to determine which works will be displayed. The artist may determine the exhibit design and may be present to assist in the installation of the exhibit.
- 2. Delivery:** The artist is responsible for the transportation of the exhibit to and from the Gallery. Vehicles should be loaded and unloaded at the loading dock on the corner of Fifth and Washington streets. Vehicles must be removed immediately after loading and unloading is completed.
- 3. Publicity:** All publicity should be coordinated through the Library. The Library may print and send post cards to a mailing list, budget permitting. All exhibits, openings and receptions are open to the general public. The artist will provide the Gallery Coordinator with an artist's statement and one photograph, six to eight weeks prior to the opening date, for use in press releases and to create a post card.
- 4. Openings and Receptions:** Exhibits may include a reception from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. on the opening date of the show. The artist provides finger foods. The Library provides beverages. A Library staff person must be present during openings.
- 5. Sales:** Artists may sell their work, but they should handle all transactions with buyers. Please provide business cards or contact information in the gallery so interested customers can get in touch. Objects sold during the exhibit should not be removed until the exhibit is over.

Directions to James Prendergast Library

1. **From west and east (I-86):** Take I-86 to Jamestown. Exit at Route 60. Take Route 60 south to Jamestown (Route 60 is North Main Street at this point). Go about 1 mile, turn right onto Sixth Street. Go 1 block, turn left onto Cherry Street, then right into the library parking lot.
2. **From north, Fredonia, Dunkirk (app. 30 miles):** Take Route 60 south to Jamestown. See #1.
3. **From south, Warren, Pa., area (app. 30 miles):** Take Route 62 north to Route 60. Turn left to Jamestown. (Route 60 becomes Foote Avenue at Jamestown). Continue on Route 60 across the Washington Street bridge. Continue north to Fifth Street; turn right. Go 1 block. Turn left onto Cherry Street; turn left into library parking lot.
4. **From east, (local, Falconer):** Take Route 394, Second Street, west. Route 394 bears right onto Fifth Street. Continue to Prendergast Avenue; turn right, go 1 block, turn left onto Sixth Street. Go 4 blocks, turn left onto Cherry Street, then right into library parking lot.
5. **From west, (local, Lakewood):** Take Route 394 east (Fairmount Avenue), bear right over Sixth Street bridge. You will now be on Fifth Street. Go several blocks, across Washington Street, then turn left at the next corner, Cherry Street. Turn left into the library parking lot.
6. **From Buffalo, (app. 70 miles):** Take I-90 west to Dunkirk exit, Route 60. See #2. *OR* Take I-90 west to Westfield exit. Take Route 394 to Stow (will pass through Mayville). Take I-86 across Chautauqua Lake to Jamestown. Take exit 12, Route 60. See #1.
7. **From Erie, (app. 50 miles):** Take I-90 east to I-86 exit, follow signs and directions for I-86 and Jamestown. Take exit 12, Route 60. See #1.
8. **From Cleveland, (app. 142 miles):** Take I-90 east to I-86 exit, follow signs and directions for I-86 and Jamestown. Take exit 12, Route 60. See #1.
9. **From Pittsburgh, (app. 153 miles):** Take I-79 to I-90, south of Erie. Take I-90 east to I-86 exit, as in #s 7 & 8. See #1.
