## Rob Buck Scholarship Established

A scholarship fund has been established in the memory of Rob Buck, lead guitarist for the 10,000 Maniacs, by the remaining members of the band. Buck died Dec. 19 in the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center of liver failure after 17 days in the center. He was 42. The fund is intended to help provide financing for college costs to students identified as deserving financial assistance. Criteria have yet to be determined for the awarding of the scholarship.
