Days," which served as Bill Clinton's Presidential campaign theme song. As *Our Time in Eden* had finished its run on the charts, Ms. Merchant announced that she was leaving for a solo career. *MTV Unplugged* was released a few months after her departure in 1993, featuring a remake of the Bruce Springsteen/Patti Smith classic, "Because the Night." The record sold four million copies.

The band continued without Ms. Merchant, adding original member Lombardo and violinist/vocalist Mary Ramsey. The band released *Love Among the Ruins* in 1997, featuring a

cover of Roxy Music's "More Than This," went to No. 24 on the Billboard charts, and was the highest-charting single in the band's history. In 1999, the band released *The Earth Pressed Flat* on Bar/None. In December 2000, Buck died of liver failure and in 2002, Ms. Ramsey and Lombardo left.

When a band that has been around as long as 10,000 Maniacs, the demographic is split, Gustafson said.

"We get parents who say 'my kids love your music' and we get kids who say 'my parents love your music' so we really cross generations. The band is rated 'E' for everybody," he said.
