filled with inexpressible emotion—particularly as I realized that Sweden has sent to Jamestown about half of this city's population. I sat in the Parliament at London and heard discussions — in that Parliament that has influenced more history than any other legislative body in the world.

"But of all these thrills none equals that I experienced as I entered my own city tonight and witnessed this fine reception. To look into the familiar faces of my own citizens on an occasion like this is a far greater thrill—and to find at my side my own good wife—that was the greatest thrill!

"Of all the countries that I have seen there is no country that equals the United States of America. And of all the governments, and I've seen the various kinds and have met the high officials of many of the smaller ones—there is no government—notwithstanding its faults, which are being rapidly corrected — there is no government on the face of the globe better than that of the United States. And of all the cities that I have seen there is no city that equals Jamestown."
