Oldtime Friends Honor Carlson On 75th Birthday

With a small group of oldtime friends about him, former Mayor Samuel A. Carlson observed his 75th birthday at noon today at a lunch at the Town Club, an occasion for an informal chat about men and events of other years. Many of the mayoralty campaigns were recalled, together with the more important events during his half century in public life, dating from 1893, when he joined the old Town Council as a representative of his home ward, the Fourth, and going down through his 10 years on the Board of Public Works, his 25 years as mayor and his more recent service as a member of the Board of Public Utilities.
