

Mayor-Emeritus Carlson's Wife Passes On, Aged 80

Mrs. Frieda Sophie Hendrickson Carlson, 80, of 115 West Summit Street, Lakewood and wife of Samuel A. Carlson, Mayor-Emeritus of Jamestown, died at home at 1:50 P.M. Sunday.

Mrs. Carlson, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Hendrickson, was born in Jamestown in October, 1872. She married Mr. Carlson June 21, 1893. The couple celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary this summer.

They made their home at 37 Maple Street until five years ago when they moved to their Lakewood residence. Mrs. Carlson had been in frail condition for some years.

Mr. Carlson was mayor of Jamestown for 26 years and has served in some official capacity from the time of his marriage to

Mrs. Carlson until 1951, when he retired from public life. He began his career when elected alderman of the Fourth Ward at the time of their marriage and since that time has served on the Board of Public Works four times besides holding the office of Mayor.

Survivors include her husband, a son, Wendell Laverne Carlson, of Princeton, N.J., two nieces, Mrs. C. Otto Lindbeck, of 65 Westminister Drive, and Miss Ruby E. Hendrickson, of 417 East Second Street, and a nephew, C. Herbert Hendrickson, of 191 Front Street, Lakewood.

Rev. Paul W. Peterson of First Mission Covenant Church will officiate at funeral services to be held at 1:30 P.M. Tuesday at Henderson-Lincoln Chapel. Burial will be in Lake View Cemetery.
