

Will Present Plaque

Mayor Carl F. Sanford, as president of the Board of Public Utilities, will present the memorial plaque, which will be unveiled by a member of Mayor Carlson's family.

Members of Mayor Carlson's immediate family who will be seated at the head table are his son, Wendell, of Princeton, N.J., and his brother, D. Lawrence Carlson, Jamestown attorney.

Tribute to the memory of two former early chairmen of the Board of Public Utilities will be paid by the presence of their sons at the head table. Paul N. Anderson, president of Dahlstrom Manufacturing Corp., whose father, the late Frank O. Anderson, was chairman of the Board from 1908 to 1923, and Marvin Peterson, former president of Crescent Tool Co., whose father, Carl Peterson, served as Board chairman from 1923 to 1933, will be at the head table with their wives.

Carl J. Fagerstrom, present chairman of the Board, will be toastmaster for the dinner. Those who will be seated at the head table also include Rev. Paul Peterson, pastor of First Covenant Church, and Mrs. Peterson; Carl Pearson, a member of the Board and Mrs. Pearson; Merle W. Smedburg, superintendent of the Board, and Mrs. Smedburg; Ernest Cawcroft, attorney who drafted Jamestown's city charter of 1923, and Inge Kihlberger, Swedish consul in Jamestown, who, with Mr. Pearson, is vice chairman of the dinner.

Guest at Luncheon
