

## Wills Of 2 Prominent Area Men Probated By Surrogate

The wills of two prominent area men, Mayor Emeritus Samuel A. Carlson and Hugh L. Gillis, former school administrator, were among five admitted to probate by Surrogate Rollin A. Fancher.

Mr. Carlson, who made his home in Lakewood, died May 14, 1961. His legatees are a son, Wendell L. Carlson, Princeton, N.J.; a sister, Ruby E. Erickson, Los Angeles, Calif.; a niece Ruby Hendrickson, 306 East Fifth Street and Eunice L. Carlson, 115 West Summit Avenue, Lakewood. The estate was estimated at \$10,000 and up each in real and personal property. Attorney for the petitioner is Mr. Carlson's brother, D. Lawrence Carlson.

Mr. Gillis, who also lived in Lakewood, left an estate estimated at \$5,000 and up in real property and \$1,000 and up in personal property. Legatees are a sister, Cora E. Gillis, 194 East Fairmount Avenue, Lakewood, a son, Raymond Gillis, St. Petersburg, Fla., and a brother, Fremont L. Thrasher, Macedon. Attorney for the petitioner is Sidney T. Hewes. Mr. Gillis died May 10, 1961.
