

Lundine Asks Unit To Eye Energy Plan

Rep. Stanley N. Lundine of Jamestown was scheduled to meet in Alfred today with members of his Science Advisory Council, as the congressman returned to the Southern Tier for a weekend of activities and speeches.

Friday night Lundine spoke to Elmira citizens about that community's economic outlook. Later today he was scheduled to attend Dairy Week activities in the Village of Cuba and address an annual Boy Scout meeting in Bradford, Pa. (for the western New York and northwest Pennsylvania area).

Lundine said he has asked his Science Advisory Council to "look very closely at President Carter's energy message and give me an analysis of its impact in the Southern Tier, as well as further suggestions for responsible legislative action."

The congressman said he has also asked council members to form task forces to look into other matters like health services, the future of the West Valley nuclear fuel site and the environment.
