Lundine To Address Falconer Grads

FALCONER — Rep. Stanley N. Lundine, 39th Congressional District of New York State, will be the speaker at commencement exercises scheduled for 7:15 p.m. Monday, June 27, at Falconer Central School. His topic will be "New Dimensions in Human Development."

Lundine is a past member of the Legislative Committee of the New York State Conference of Mayors; the Com-

munity Development Committee of the National League of Cities; the U.S. Conference of Mayors; and a former director of the Southern Tier West Planning Board of New York State. He is also a member of a number of community service and fraternal organizations.

Lundine, re-elected to office in general elections in November, 1976, now serves on the Committee on Banking, Finance

and Urban Affairs and subcommittees for Housing and Community Development, Economic Stabilization and International Trade, Investment and Monetary Policy. He also serves on the House Select Committee for the Aging subcommittees for Health and Long Term Care and Housing and Consumer Interests.
