Lundine went on to say, "I believe that I have kept these promises. I am proud of the record I have established in Washington as an advocate of the people of the Southern Tier. The speaker said he feels inflation is the nation's single greatest problem at present and strong measures must be taken to check it. In promising his supporters a hard fought campaign, Lundine said, "I'm both proud and grateful for the overwhelming public support I have received in the past two elections. I pledge to you that I will work as hard as a candidate as I do as a member of Congress and with your help I believe we will have another victorious campaign in November."

The 39th Congressional District includes all of Chautauqua, Cattaraugus and Allegany Counties, a small part of Erie County and much of Steuben and Chemung Counties, including Corning, Hornell and Elmira.

Lundine met Saturday morning with members of the Retired Senior Volunteer Program in St. James School in Jamestown to discuss programs of the Select Committee on Aging.

During the afternoon he held "town meetings" in Falconer and Salamanca. At the latter meeting, several Kill Buck residents sought his assistance in keeping heavy truck traffic off a road in their area but he pointed out there is no federal prohibition against it.

Lundine met late Saturday afternoon with representatives of Chautauqua County Gun Owners Federation and took part Sunday afternoon in the "Golden Mile" walk of Chautauqua County March of Dimes Chapter. He then left for various functions in Chemung County en route back to Washington.
