

Lundine Has Busy Weekend In District

Rep. Stanley N. Lundine (D-39th) of Jamestown is back in Washington after a busy weekend.

The activity included two commencement addresses, town meetings, discussions with energy and health advisory committees, an address at an Allegany County conference on the elderly and office hours at his Jamestown office Monday.

The graduation talks were given at Notre Dame High School in Elmira and Andover Central School. The conference on the elderly was attended by about 120 persons who were told by Lundine that as the only member of Congress on the housing subcommittees of both the banking and aging committees he has been in a position to have considerable impact on national elderly housing policy.

Electric energy rate reform was discussed at Cuba Central School with the legislator's energy committee while his health advisory group considered hospital costs containment, national health insurance and medical technology.

The town meetings, open to anyone in the area, were held in Wellsville and Frewsburg.
