

Lundine Sets Campaign Heads

Jamestown Mayor Steven B. Carlson has been named general chairman, Helen Ebersole has been named Chautauqua County citizens chairman, and John Anderson has been named finance chairman of Rep. Stanley N. Lundine's reelection campaign, Lundine's office has announced.

"I am very pleased that these talented people have agreed to provide the leadership for the citizens who will carry out the various volunteer activities of this

campaign," Lundine said. "Steve Carlson's advice has been invaluable to me from my first campaign for mayor in 1969 until now when he has particular insight on congressional decisions affecting local communities. I appreciate his willingness to provide policy direction for the campaign across this district."

Lundine served as mayor of Jamestown before his election to Congress in March, 1976. Carlson, then serving as Chautauqua County clerk, was elected to succeed him by the Jamestown City Council. Lundine was re-elected for a full term of office in 1976 and Carlson was re-elected mayor in November, 1977.

"Helen Ebersole and John Anderson are both long-time friends whose civic leadership and past political support make them excellent persons to head the Chautauqua County campaign," Lundine said.

Mrs. Ebersole is a member of the Southwestern District School Board and the Historical Society of Jamestown. Anderson, a former Chautauqua County legislator, is president of a local stock brokerage firm and a director of the Jamestown Civic Ballet.

Miles Lasser of Jamestown will serve as treasurer of the campaign committee and R. Michael Goldman, also of Jamestown, will serve as legal counsel, Lundine's office announced.

Lasser, a former member of the Jamestown City Council and former president of the James Prendergast Library, is

managing partner of a local accounting firm. Goldman is a member of a local law firm and also serves as an at-large councilman in Jamestown. He is president of radio station WDOE in Dunkirk.

Lundine also named Gary Michalak of Dunkirk and Phillip Cenedella of Fredonia as deputy chairmen of his general reelection drive and finance effort, respectively.

In other counties across the district, Lundine named Ben Perreault of Salamanca to serve as Cattaraugus County Citizens chairman and Mike Shane of Allegany as finance chairman.

Mike Brace of Almond will serve as Allegany County Citizens chairman and Mike Schaffner of Bolivar as Finance chairman. Al Johnson of Bath will serve as Steuben County Citizens Chairman and Al Winston of Elmira will serve as Chemung County Citizens chairman. Bob Carroll of West Elmira will act as Chemung County finance chairman.
