Snyder said he was disappointed in losing Chautauqua County, but was impressed by his support in Chemung County, where he drew almost 44 percent of the vote.

Maguire said he was thrilled to receive 61 percent of the vote. "I had no way of knowing what to expect, this being my

first shot (at campaigning for office).

"We've run a pretty clean campaign, attacking the issues. We'll be united in a strong Republican campaign from here on," he said.

Maguire, a Franciscan priest on a leave of absence from a vice presidency at St. Bonaventure University in Olean, ran

against the record of the incumbent Lundine during most of the primary campaign.

Maguire, 49, has stated that his objectives in office would be to reduce the size of government, curb inflation, maintain a strong defense and team up with Rep. Jack Kemp to reduce federal taxes.
