

Lundine Names Two To Staff

Rep. Stanley Lundine, D-Jamestown, has announced appointments of two new staff people in his congressional office.

Alan S. Winston of Elmira will assume responsibilities for media relations and programs as well as coordination with community groups and citizens in the Southern Tier. He replaces Steve Sprague as director of communications.

Sara Sibley, a native of Ohio, is Lundine's new administrative assistant, with responsibilities for the general operation of his congressional offices.

She replaces Ann Lewis, who is taking a similar position with Rep. Barbara Mikulski, D-Md. Sprague also went with another congressman, Rep. Gary Lee, R-N.Y.

Winston was community schools coordinator for the Elmira City School District, and has served on the faculty of Elmira College for 10 years as an instructor in federal, state and local government.

Sibley served with former Ohio Gov. John J. Gilligan before joining Lundine's staff in 1976. She has acted as legislative assistant for housing and social service issues, besides working on railroad reorganization, community development funding and elderly housing.
