

# Little Valley Will Host Lundine

LITTLE VALLEY Democratic Congressman Stanley N. Lundine will be the guest of honor during the Little Valley Democrats "Meet your candidate coffee and canape hour" this Friday following Lundine's Little Valley town meeting. The coffee hour will be at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest R. Hand Jr. and will begin approximately at 9:15 p.m.

Democratic Town Supervisor Joseph W. Hale said Lundine will also be meeting with the Little Valley Democratic endorsed village candidates and Little Valley committeemen during a dinner meeting at 6 p.m. at the Coachman's Inn

prior to his town meeting which is scheduled to take place at 7:30 p.m. at the Civil Defense Center in the Cattaraugus County Building.

Hale urged the residents of Little Valley and the surrounding areas to attend the town meeting to talk over the problems of the area and to ask the congressman questions relating to this particular district.

"It will be the first time that Congressman Lundine is holding a town meeting in Little Valley and this type of meeting affords the congressman an opportunity to speak with his constituents on

a more personal level and at the same time listen to what is on their minds. It also gives the constituents an opportunity to relate to the congressman some of their viewpoints and interests," Hale said.
