

Alliance Again Scene of Fire

Tended Blaze Goes Out of Control

Ruins of the Alliance Furniture Company, 615 Allen Street, which was destroyed in a \$500,000 fire last July, caught fire again Friday night.

City firemen were called to the scene at 8:18 P.M. when a fire started by a local contracting firm to burn away the July fire wreckage got out of control.

Three hose lines were used to extinguish the blaze, which temporarily threatened the nearby Plomb Tool Company plant. The site is being cleared for use as a parking lot by Plomb Tool employees.

A barn owned by George Parsons at 223 Pennsylvania Avenue was damaged in a \$300 fire Friday afternoon. The fire, blamed on sparks from a nearby bonfire, caused extensive damage to the barn's interior and some loss to the roof and walls. Two large water lines were used by city firemen to extinguish the blaze.

Firemen were also called to the Playdium Bowling Alleys, 2229 Washington Street, at 9:55 A.M. today to investigate a reported odor of smoke. No fire was found, but firemen said the odor could have been caused by a nearby rubbish fire.
