

Creston Office To Be Rebuilt

Permit Issued to Transfer Company

The Creston Transfer Company, Grand Rapids, Mich., Tuesday, was granted a permit to build a \$12,500 one-story concrete building at 612 Allen Street, site of its former Jamestown office which was destroyed by fire, July 16. The permit was granted by Ralph E. Carmichael, city building inspector.

The Alliance Furniture Company plant across the street from Creston, also was destroyed in the half-million dollar blaze.

Since the fire, the Creston firm has been operating in buildings at 1001 Monroe Street. The new building will be used for storage and office space. The Creston office here serves as a trucking terminal plant, hauling new furniture out of Jamestown to points west.

Other building permits were issued to:

Jasper Allette, a \$7,000 one-story ranch-style frame home at 598 Falconer Street; and Sam Lundquist, Jr., interior alterations estimated at \$1,500 at 335 East Fifth Street.
