AVM Completes Sale Of Elections Systems

All transactions involving sale of its Election Systems Division to a recently formed company have been completed, AVM Corp. has announced.

The former division now is owned by Automatic Voting Machine Corp. of which Thomas H. Huhn, AVM's sales representative for New York State and New England for many years, is president.

The sale of the business resulted in a loss of \$82,000, which is included in AVM's 1978 financial results, reflecting the transaction as a discontinued operation. AVM reported 1978 sales from continuing operations of \$37,583,000, which does not include Election Systems Division sales of \$5,593,000.
