

# Rogerson Gets Art Metal Post

## Local Attorney On Executive Committee

J. Russell Rogerson, Jamestown attorney, has been named to the executive committee of the Art Metal, Inc., Board of Directors, it was learned today.

Mr. Rogerson is one of three new directors, all from Jamestown, who were named to the Board when it met Dec. 15 in Boston, Mass.

At the December meeting, the Board also made its plans to reorganize the firm, then known as Art Metal Construction Company, into a New York State corporation. Until Jan. 1, this year, it had been incorporated in Massachusetts. Stockholders approved the reorganization at a meeting Dec. 17.

The executive committee, of five directors, operates between meetings of the full 14-man Board.

Other members of the executive board are Andrew Wilson, New York, chairman of the Board; Roscoe W. Clark, president of Art Metal's Jamestown division; John L. Riegel, Hartsdale; and Fergus Reid, Jr., New York.

Meanwhile, Mr. Rogerson and the other new Jamestown directors toured plant facilities in Jamestown this morning to acquaint themselves with the firm's operations. The two other Jamestown directors are Benjamin H. Cravens, president of Jamestown Telephone Corporation; and Falconer Jones, president of American Manufacturing Concern.

Mr. Rogerson pointed out there are now more local directors on the Board than there have been for many years, since the days of Henry K. Smith's presidency of the firm in the 1930's.
