

# Art Metal Sales Offices Move Here

## New York Offices To Close Next Week In Transfer

Art Metal, Inc., is expected to have all its executive offices located in Jamestown by next week, according to Roscoe W. Clark, company vice president, who also announced two changes in the firm's executive lineup.

Benjamin H. Cravens, president of the Jamestown Telephone Corporation, has been elected to Art Metal's executive committee, replacing Andrew Wilson, Scarsdale, who resigned from the board of directors and executive committee of Art Metal last month.

In addition, F. H. Brown, treasurer of Art Metal, was elected to the board of directors to fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Mrs. Florence Knoll, New York City.

Mrs. Knoll was president of Knoll Associates, Inc., Knoll Textiles, Inc., and Knoll International, purchased by Art Metal in 1959.

Mr. Cravens, who lives at 121 Arlington Avenue, was named to Art Metal's board of directors last January. He has headed the Jamestown Telephone Corporation since 1951 and holds directorships with other local firms.

Mr. Clark announced the changes today after his return from a board of directors' meeting yesterday in New York City.

Movement of Art Metal executive offices to Jamestown was ratified at a company directors' meeting Nov. 10.

Mr. Clark said the movement is expected to be completed by next week and will mean the closing of the company's offices maintained at 50 West 44th Street in New York City.

To complete the move, Ray J. Dervey, vice president in charge of sales and marketing; Donald Fillpot, dealer sales manager and Jack Clarke, sales manager branch operation, as well as other staff members, will move to Jamestown next week.
