

# Falconer Jones Reelected Head Of Art Metal, Inc.

## Annual Stockholders Meeting Conducted In Avenel, N.J.

Falconer Jones was reelected president of Art Metal, Inc., at the company's annual stockholders' meeting yesterday. Mr. Jones is also president of American Manufacturing Concern of Falconer.

The annual meeting, the first since the company changed its name, was held at Security Steel, the firm's Avenel, N.J., subsidiary. The name was changed from Art Metal Construction Company to Art Metal, Inc., following a special reorganization meeting last Dec. 17.

Mr. Jones was first named president and chief executive officer at the company's Feb. 26, 1960, board of directors' meeting.

Other officers named at yesterday's meeting are Roscoe W. Clark of Jamestown and Arthur G. Whyte, Jr., L. R. Addington, Hugh G. Clark and Ralph R. Davis, all vice presidents; Carl H. Bowen, secretary and treasurer; John McPeak, controller and assistant secretary and Paul E. Moore, assistant secretary and assistant treasurer.

A plan, first announced following the firm's Jan. 1, 1960 board of directors' meeting, to reduce the number of directors from 14 to 9 was adopted yesterday.

The nine directors elected are Roscoe W. Clark, Benjamin H. Cravens, Falconer Jones and J. Russell Rogerson, all of Jamestown, and Charles L. Kaufman, Florence Knoll, Burgess Reid, Jr., John L. Riegel and Andrew Wilson.

A decision to pass the first quarterly dividend in 1960 was announced at the meeting. Reasons for the decision will be contained in the president's forthcoming report to the stockholders, a company director said.
