

# 77 Employees MAY 17 1960 Of Art Metal On Retirement

## Carl H. Swanson Heads List With 56 Years Service

A total of 77 employees of Art Metal, Inc., was retired today, according to provisions of the Art Metal Retirement Plan, establishing mandatory retirement at the age of 68.

Three were from the office and 74 from the factory.

In the group were 12 with more than 40 years of service with Art Metal.

Effective date of the Retirement Plan is today, May 17. A spokesman for Art Metal, Inc., announced that the Trustee of the Retirement Plan is the Chautauqua National Bank of Jamestown.

He announced that the first retirement checks will be mailed to those retiring today by about the end of this month. It was also reported that 12 more employees will retire by the end of this year.

Dean of all who retired today is Carl H. Swanson, 364 Fairmount Avenue, with 56 years, and a close second is Fred O. Melquist, 7 Butler Street, 54 years. Two others with more than 50 years are Claus H. Anderson, 12 Carey Place, 53 years; and Charles A. Anderson, Willard Extension, 51 years.

Others retiring who have been employed at Art Metal more than 40 years are Miss Mabel L. Harris, McDannell Avenue, office worker since 1915; Joseph Trusso, 226 Hazard Street, factory worker since 1912; Carl A. Dahlberg, 46 Peterson Street and Corydon J. Marker, Elmhurst, both since 1916; Oscar Herman, 452 Rront Street, since 1917; Carmelo Crasi, 45 Hazzard Street and J. Edwin Carlson, 125 Hall Avenue, both since 1918; and C. Harry Swan, since 1919.

Each is eligible for pension, and is also privileged to carry life insurance on a participating basis, the company carrying the greatest part of the expense. The retirees may also convert and carry their hospital and surgical insurance at reduced rates.

Most of the retiring workers have been honored at small informal parties by co-workers and supervisors of departments.
