Art Metal, Inc., Reports Merger Of 3 Subsidiaries

Ralph R. Davis, Raymond Dervey Named To Posts

The merger of three wholly owned subsidiaries into Art Metal, Inc., is announced today by the president, Falconer Jones.

These include the Security Steel Equipment Corporation at Avenel, N.J.; Wabash Filing Supplies, Inc., at Wabash, Ind.; and the Spartan Metal Corporation, Spartanburg, South Carolina.

Mr. Jones also announced two new corporate appointments, as well as the divisional plant managers.

Effective July 1, Raymond J. Dervey of St. Paul, Minn., is the director of sales and marketing for Art Metal, Inc., and Ralph R. Davis of Plainfield, N.J., is director of manufacturing.

These are two new broad corporate responsibilities for the whole of Art Metal, Inc., Mr. Jones said.

Army Officer

Since his discharge from the U. S. Army in 1945 as a lieutenant colonel, Mr. Dervey has served as a sales executive for several large corporations and also as a management and sales consultant.

More recently Mr. Dervey was president and general manager of a large midwestern manufacturer of metal products.

In speaking of his appointment, Mr. Jones said, "We welcome Mr. Dervey as a member of our organization and feel confident that his background as a graduate engineer of mines and metallurgy from the University of Minnesota, and his experience in manufacturing and sales will be of great value to our organization."

Art Metal Veteran

Mr. Davis, who has been appointed director of manufacturing, has been with Art Metal for 41 years. He first was employed in the Jamestown plant where he received his early training in manufacture and sale of Art Metal products. Since then he has served in the sales department as a salesman and branch manager.

In 1936, Mr. Davis was assigned to new duties with the Security Steel Equipment Corporation, wholly acquired subsidiary of Art Metal. From that time until May 31 of this year, he continued to serve that company as general sales manager, vice president, general manager and president.

Elected a vice president of Art Metal in December, 1958, Mr. Davis has been given various assignments leading up this new appointment. He is related to the Misses Elinor and Blanche Davis of this city.

In announcing the appointment

of Mr. Davis to his new post, Mr. Jones said that he feels confident with his background in manufacturing and sales, Mr. Davis will be of great value to the organization.
