Art Metal Picks Seaberg As New Vice President In Charge Of Promotion

Art Metal, Inc. has appointed W. R. Seaberg of Red Bank, N.J., as vice president in charge of national sales promotion at the firm's New York City office.

With the exception of World War II Naval service and a short period with Western Electric, Inc., Mr. Seaberg has been a member

of the Art Metal staff since 1948.

He will make his headquarters at 41 East Forty Second Street, New York City, according to an announcement by Raymond J. Dervey, vice president of sales and marketing.

Mr. Seaberg served as lieutenant commander in the Navy's Supply Division during World War II. Following his discharge from the Navy in 1947, he became New York branch manager of sales.

Along with the announcement of the firm's new sales official, the company also confirmed an order from the U. S. Government for desks.

The desks will be produced at Art Metal's Avenel, N.J., plant. The Jamestown office was unable to immediately report the size of the order as most of the top officials here were out of town today.

A government contract for desks also was awarded to General Fireproofing Company of Youngstown, O. In a recent request by the government for two desk bids, the Corry-Jamestown Company of Corry failed to win a contract. They were the third lowest bidder.
