## Judge To Speak At Start Of 'Twelve Angry Men'

The Honorable John T. Ward, Chautauqua County Court judge, will present an opening night address before the Bunbury Theatre Company's production of *Twelve Angry Men*, hosted by the Robert H. Jackson Center for Justice, at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 13, at The Jackson Center, 305 Fourth St., with the play to follow.

Ward will speak about jury duty and the importance of the play, originally a teleplay starring Henry Fonda, and its impact on American thought and education concerning the topics of guilty, not guilty and reasonable doubt. *Twelve Angry Men* is often viewed as the benchmark for all modern courtroom dramas and is a cornerstone of U.S. government classes in our schools and universities today.

The production of *Twelve Angry Men* marks the one-year anniversary of The Bunbury Theatre Company. Other performances will be at 7 p.m. Nov. 14, 15 and 16, and at 2 p.m. Nov. 17.
