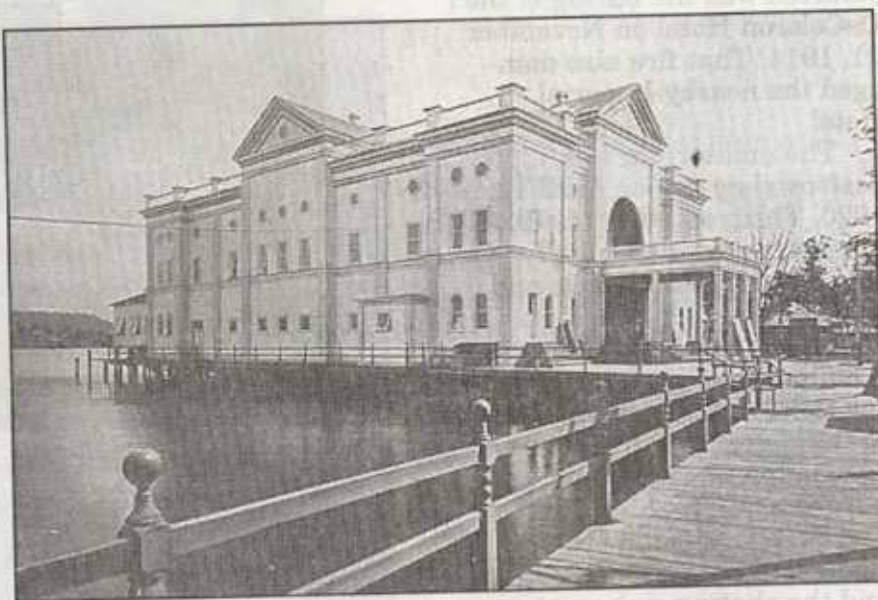


The Lakeview Hotel - September 1940

known as the Yellow Submarine restaurant, burned beyond repair. The Lakeview Hotel burned in 1988 and was considered to be the last original building of the Celoron Park days. It was one of the oldest buildings in town, having been built in 1891.

One fire concerned a 100 gallon still, said to be the largest and best equipped in the county. In 1925 the fire started on the north side of Fairmount Avenue nearly opposite the Lakeview Rose Gardens on Merlin Avenue. Carmello Calabrese called the fire department and disappeared, and his whereabouts remained a local mystery. The fire endangered other property in the thickly settled Italian community.
