

New Election For Crawford Employees Set

A new bargaining election for employees of the Crawford Furniture Manufacturing Corporation has been set for Friday, July 11 by the National Labor Relations Board. It was announced today by Clyde Crawford, company president.

In the election, employees will cast their ballots either for the independent union at the plant or for the CIO Furniture Workers as their bargaining agent.

In a previous election last March, employees voted for the independent union in an 88 to 55 vote. The election was ordered set aside by the NLRB after it upheld a CIO protest that company officials had "participated in anti-union activities prior to the election" without allowing the union to reply to the company's allegations.
