

Crawfords Not To Leave City, Plant Either

Separate Company Will Operate at New Bethlehem, Pa.

Operation of the Crawford Furniture Manufacturing Company in Jamestown will not be discontinued and Mr. and Mrs. Clyde Crawford will continue to make their home in the Jamestown area, it was stated today by Mr. Crawford upon his return to the city following announcement of the formation of a new company and plans to build a plant in New Bethlehem, Pa.

Announcement of the plan to form a new company and build a new half million dollar plant at New Bethlehem was made in The Post-Journal last Thursday. This announcement made at New Bethlehem also stated that another half million dollars is included in the company financing for new machinery and equipment.

Mr. Crawford stated that while he expects to spend about half of his time on the New Bethlehem enterprise, it would not require his moving his home from this area.

He further stated that the new company now being formed will not be a part of the Jamestown corporation. It will be a Pennsylvania corporation with an entirely different board of directors from the Jamestown company. It is also planned to make an entirely different line of furniture, he stated. The only officer to serve in both companies will be Mr. Crawford, who will serve as president of both corporations, the statement related.
