## FALLING METAL CAUSES FLOOD

A lift of sheet steel, being unloaded by an overhead crane, dropped this morning, breaking a 2-inch water pipe and unleashing a miniature flood in the steel storage department of the Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company.

Fire Department authorities said about 5,000 gallons of water flooded the department when the pipe, which is an extension of the sprinkler system, broke.

An official of the company said no one was injured. He added that operations were not interrupted. The water was drained into an elevator shaft where it was removed by an automatic pump.
