

Strike Parley At Dahlstrom Raises Hopes

Statements, When Made, to Come From Company and Union

Sources close to the negotiations of labor and management at strikebound Dahlstrom Metallic Door today indicated definite hope of an early settlement. The parley resumed at 9:30 A.M. today.

It was reported that company and union officials will meet again this afternoon and possibly Saturday.

More than 600 members of UE Local 307 went on strike at the plant Feb. 7. Demands are for a general wage increase, a company - paid insurance plan and two additional holidays.

Clarence Lamotte, U.S. conciliator who is conducting the meetings, said today no statements concerning the negotiations would be issued until both the union and company issue statements simultaneously.

Meanwhile, pickets of Local 307 have maintained a constant vigil at the plants entrances. A soup kitchen is being maintained in the vicinity for the pickets.
