Talks Resume

Union Prepares Strike Statement

Negotiations at Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company were scheduled to resume at 2 P.M. today. The union, U.E. Local 307, met this morning in Nordic Temple. Union officials were not available for comment following the meeting.

It was reported, however, a statement would be made at 5 P.M. today. Another meeting between union and company has been set for 11 A.M., Wednesday.

Results or progress of the negotiations between officials of the strikebound plant and the union strike committee were not reported by either side.

About 600 employes of the company went on strike Feb. 7. Demands are for a general wage increase, a company paid insurance plan, and two additional paid holidays a year.

Clarence Lamotte, U.S. conciliator, will not be present at today's meeting in the Dahlstrom plant office.

The meeting of union members today reportedly was called for the purpose of outlining the progress of the union's negotiating committee during last week's meetings with company officials.

Picketing at entrances to the Dahlstrom plant has continued since the first day of the walk-out, on a day and night schedule.
