

Dahlstrom's Strike Parley Is Suspended

Negotiations aimed at settling the strike at Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company have been temporarily suspended.

Wage re-opener parleys ended Friday afternoon and the next meeting of company and union officials is subject to call by Federal Conciliator Clarence LaMotte of Buffalo.

No reason for the suspension of negotiations was given by the conciliator, union officials or company heads.

Demands by the union are a company-paid insurance plan, a general wage increase and two additional paid holidays a year. Some 600 members of UE Local 307 went on strike Feb. 7.

Some sources indicated possibilities of a meeting between union and company officials before Mr. LaMotte returns to Jamestown. Mr. LaMotte hinted he may return to Jamestown Wednesday.

The general strike committee of Local 307 was scheduled to meet in Nordic Temple this morning to discuss the negotiations.

The speaker for the "Voice of Labor" program over Station WJTN, Sunday at 6:20 P.M., will be Edward Berg, chairman of the strike food committee of Local 307.
