

# Contract Talks Continuing

## No Agreement At Morning Meet

Negotiations for a contract settlement between union officials and Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company officers resumed this afternoon, a spokesman for the company reported.

A meeting between union and company officials and the U.S. Conciliation Service at 11 A.M. today resulted in "no accomplishments" according to a company source.

The final attempt to avert a strike at the plant was made today at the request of U.S. Conciliator Clarence Lamotte of Buffalo. He could not be reached for comment after the meeting this morning.

Union demands include a general wage increase, two additional paid holidays, an insurance clause and a pension plan. Approximately 600 employees would be affected by a walkout.

The workers are represented by Local 307, United Electrical, Radio & Machine Workers. Authorization was given the union's negotiating committee last week to call a strike at any time if the union and company fail to reach agreement.
