## Signs of Parley Reopening Fade

"Members of UE Local 307 have dug in for a long strike if a long strike is necessary to win their demands," it was declared Wednesday night in a statement issued by the strike committee. ~~The union members, employees of Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company, went on strike Feb. 7.~~

~~Demands are for a general wage increase, a company-paid insurance plan and two additional paid holidays a year. Negotiations between union and company management broke down last week.~~

No new negotiations have been scheduled. The statement of Local 307's general strike committee is as follows:

"After 23 days of the strike at the Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company, picketing continues around the clock. The strike is 100 per cent effective and the morale of the strikers is high. All strike machinery is running smoothly and members of UE Local 307 have dug in for a long strike if a long strike is necessary to win their demands.

"Support of labor and the community as a whole is very gratifying. Continued support both financially and morally will undoubtedly make this strike of short duration."

The committee announced that movies for the strikers' children will be shown at Nordic Temple at 2 P.M. Sunday.
