Dahlstrom's Parley Called Optimistic

Chances that the 119-day old strike at Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company will end in the near future appeared somewhat brighter today as company officials met with representatives of Local 307, United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers (Ind.), for the third negotiations session in as many days.

The current talks amount to the first lengthy negotiations conducted since the walkout of about 650 production workers began on June 15.

Andrew P. Anderson, Local 307 president said no agreement was reached during Wednesday's meeting.
