

Dahlstrom Talks To Resume Monday

Negotiators attempting to settle the 119-day-old strike at the Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company recessed Thursday afternoon without reaching an agreement, but will resume meetings at 2:30 P.M. Monday.

The meeting on the street, along with some company executives and union members, is beginning to view the strike talks with increasing optimism that the city's longest industrial dispute of the year may be settled sometime next week.
