

Guarantee Of Payroll Wins Factory

Salamanca — A guarantee of a \$400,000 annual payroll by the first of next year and a \$200,000 guaranteed payroll for this year and a token payment of \$1 were given the city of Salamanca in return for title to the old McCabe Furniture Company factory by the Fancher Furniture Company Friday night.

The City Council awarded the plant unanimously. The title to the plant had been obtained by the city through tax default. Mayor Frank Newton said that the move meant an additional employment of 175 persons. The company at present employs about 125 persons at the concern's present plant adjacent to the newly acquired property. Both buildings front on the Erie and Baltimore and Ohio railroad tracks on the city's north side.

The Fancher Company plans to manufacture plywood television cabinets at the new plant it was reported. New machinery will be installed as soon as possible so that production on new orders may start by July 1.
