

# Jury Selection In \$500,000 Civil Action Started

## Salamanca Company's Suit Brought Against New York City Firm

Little Valley—Selection of a jury for trial of a \$500,000 damage suit brought by the Fancher Furniture Company, Salamanca, against the Arabol Manufacturing Company, New York City, got under way in Supreme Court here this morning. Justice Hamilton Ward is presiding.

The Salamanca company claims that defective glue purchased from the Arabol company in 1946 and 1947 caused it heavy losses in good will and through repairs and replacement of furniture.

Two counts in the complaint charge breach of warranty and two others charge misrepresentation. The damages sought by the company include transportation charges for return and reshipment of furniture, administrative and re-work charges and the loss of good will.

The Arabol company has filed a general denial, asserting that the Salamanca company bought \$1,871 worth of glue following tests of samples. It also denied giving a warranty and asserted that a label affixed on each container gave notice that the company assumed no liability beyond actual purchase price.
