

Arabol Pays Fancher Co. Judgment

New York. (A.P.)—Counsel for the Arabol Manufacturing Company today announced no appeal would be taken in the ~~reduced~~ award of damages to the Fancher Furniture Company of Salamanca.

A Cattaraugus County jury last November awarded Fancher \$120,000 damages and another \$100,000 for "loss of reputation and good will" in a suit claiming glue bought from Arabol was defective.

Supreme Court Justice Hamilton Ward held that the amount was excessive and ruled that unless Fancher agreed to a reduced award of \$120,000 there must be a new trial.

In a stipulation filed with the county clerk at Little Valley last month, Fancher agreed to accept the reduced amount, providing no appeal was filed by Arabol. Meantime, Justice Ward agreed to grant Fancher an additional allowance of \$2,000 permitted under the law, plus \$1,081.28 in costs.

McNamara & Seymour, counsel for Arabol, said the company had decided not to appeal, and that the judgment has been settled. The law firm said settlement papers will be filed in Little Valley within a few days.
