Expects to Revamp Maddox Block

Theodore W. Berenson, of Boston, announced today he had purchased title to the Maddox Building on Third Street, forecasting future commercial activity in the two-story structure.

The building, formerly the site of the W. T. Grant Company store, was owned by the Prudential Insurance Company which had leased it to Mr. Berenson.

He said he plans to modernize the building front and revamp the interior for commercial tenants.

W. T. Grant Company is now located in a new building at Third and Washington Street, which is occupied on a lease arrangement with Mr. Berenson.

Mr. Berenson said this is his only other real estate holding in Jamestown.
