sage through the center. This block alone covers nearly two acres. The central potting sheds are 460 feet long by 25 feet wide, the lower end being used as a carpenter shop for making shipping boxes, etc.

"The smoke stack, which is built of pressed brick, looms 100 feet high and is 20 feet at the base.

"The specialties of this concern are roses, carnations, palms, smilax, chrysanthemums and asparagus. About 70,000 roses are planted, one block being devoted to American Beauties, another to other varieties, Liberty, the new rose, has a place among the rest and has a bright future before it.

"All the leading, both standard and new, carnations are grown.

"C. H. Roney is manager of this immense concern, which employs 44 regular help not counting office and sales people."

As with most Broadhead enterprises, no trace remains of this huge complex, but it will long be remembered by many old timers. Jamestown owes much to
