

# PLAYERS' CLUB IS HONORED

**Local Organization Invited To Present Three Plays at Chautauqua During Coming Season.**

The Players' Club of this city has received an invitation from the Chautauqua management to stage an evening of its dramatic productions in the Chautauqua Amphitheater the coming season, which marks the celebration of the institution's fiftieth anniversary. In reply to Dr. Besor's letter expressing the hope that the Players' Club can perform this valuable service, Mrs. John M. Cushman, president of the club and acting upon its behalf, has accepted the invitation and it is expected that the local players will appear at Chautauqua on an evening early in July.

At its Chautauqua appearance the Players' Club will stage three of its one-act plays, these probably including "The Vallant," dramatized from the story by Holworthy Hall and which the club produced this winter in the Sherman Street School auditorium, and "The Littlest Girl," by Richard Harding Davis, which has been given several times here by Messrs. Pinder and Ormsby as the principals. The third play to be presented has not yet been chosen.

The scenic equipment for the presentation of dramatic productions on the Amphitheater platform is necessarily limited to drapery background and the Players' Club has had select its proposed productions with this requirement in mind.

It is understood that another evening of plays is to be given by the Erie organization of community players.
