

Little Theater Will Select Cast For 'Monique' On Sunday

CASTING for Little Theater's second production of the season will be held at 3 P.M., Sunday, at LT headquarters, 414 Fairmount Avenue. Paul W. Weinbach, director, has announced.

The play, "Monique," by Dorothy and Michael Blankfort, is a mystery involving the eternal triangle and the problem of getting rid of the unwanted third party.

But there its similarity to run-of-the-mill triangular love affairs ends.

The master mind that weaves the whole diabolic plot is that of Monique, an attractive and dominating woman doctor.

She ensnares Fernand, a man of good will unhappily married to the shrewish Lucienne, and implants

in his tormented mind the obsession that Lucienne must be removed.

Together they hatch one of the most ingenious murder plots in the history of crime, execute it, and are apparently successful.

Then comes the dessert they had not anticipated, involving terrifying suspense and a touch of the supernatural.

One 17-year-old girl and five men and four women between the ages of 35 and 60 are need for the drama's 10 roles.
