

LT 'The Drunkard' Play Will Feature Gay 90s Atmosphere

The swinging doors, red checkered tablecloths, honky-tonk piano and barbershop harmony of a gay nineties cafe will return briefly when the Little Theater stages a studio production of "The Drunkard" early in January.

Right now LT is looking for a cast for the production, Paul W. Weinbach, director, has announced.

Tryouts are scheduled for 3-5 P.M., Sunday, and 8-10 P.M., Monday at Little Theater Headquarters, 414 Fairmount Avenue.

Actors, actresses, singers and dancers are needed, Mr. Weinbach said. Individuals and groups with

appropriate novelty numbers to perform will be welcomed. And there will be a place for anyone with ideas on decorating a gay nineties cafe.

The entire first floor of LT headquarters will be decked out for the production like one of the old-time fun spots, he said.

Cafe tables and chairs for the audience will be scattered informally throughout the room in full view of the stage.

The production will run for about two weeks in January at a date to be announced.
