

LT Play Set At Alumni Reunion Here

Little Theater's presentation of "The Choir Rehearsal" by Clare Kummer and music by the Jamestown Municipal Band will highlight the program of the 100th anniversary reunion of Jamestown High School Alumni at 8 p.m. Friday in the high school auditorium.

Mrs. Harvey M. Osgood is directing the play, chosen because of its 1860 setting as fitting for the centennial reunion. Players Club, the forerunner of Little Theater, took first prize for presentation of the play in a contest in Pittsburgh, Pa., back in the 1920's.

Joseph Midgley of the original cast will take part. Other members of the cast are Mrs. Joseph Wilbur, Marshall Dahlin, Paul R. Weinbach, Bruce Gustafson and Miss Michelle Pringle of Randolph.

The band, in which several musicians are former Jamestown High School Band members, will play under direction of Keith Emanuelson.

Brian Bogey will be at the organ for the processional of classes from various classrooms into the auditorium.

Raymond Fox, alumni president, will preside at the opening of the program. Komo Tane will be toastmaster.

Responses will be given by the honor classes of 1918, 1928, 1943, 1953, 1958 and this year's class. The One Hundred Member Club will present a gift of \$100 to the graduate chosen by classmates and faculty for this honor.

Refreshments will be served by the 1953 class. Opportunity will be given to inspect the new addition to the high school.

Classrooms are assigned to all alumni to meet as early as 7 p.m. for a visit with classmates before the program.
