# Little Theater Drive Passes 3,000 Mark

The current Little Theater of Jamestown membership drive passed the 3,000 mark, according to tallies made at a final report meeting last night at LT headquarters.

Mrs. Helen Merrill, drive chairman; Mrs. Madelyn Osgood, honorary chairman and Marshall B. Dahlin, administrative aid, said indications are that a "clean up" of reports from 160 volunteer workers will bring the present 3,032 total closer to the projected 3,300 goal.

Mrs. Merrill said enrollments will be accepted through the run of the first play of the 1969-70 season, "A Majority of One," which opens early in December.
