

Little Theatre Winner Of 4 Acting Awards

FREDONIA — The Little Theatre of Jamestown won four acting awards Saturday with its entry in the Area 9 New York State Theatre Festival Association Competition held at Fredonia State College.

The play chosen for the festival was "Please, No Flowers," by Joel Ensana, originally staged for the Italian Festival in Jamestown last summer.

Acting awards for leading performances were given to Cynthia Peterson and Armede Brown. An award for best performance in a supporting role was give to Jim Roseile, and Doris Wilbur received an award for a special vignette performance.

The play was recommended for participation at the state festival.

Other members of the cast were Lucy Alpaugh, Marjorie Broadhead, Laurretta Baldwin, Durwood Engwall and Sam Paladino. It was directed by Marshall Dahlin, with setting by Daniel Woodard.

Other theater groups participating from Western New York were the Mummers and the Pierians from Fredonia State College, the Dunkirk-Fredonia Players, the Appletown Players from Buffalo, who received the best play award, and the group from Buffalo State University.

The state festival will be held the weekend before Thanksgiving in Cortland.
