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119 \$30,000 an episode.  
120 From that series, the couple devel-  
121 oped Desilu into a major TV production  
122 company that in its prime produced  
123 more than 19 TV programs, including  
124 "The Lucy-Desi Comedy Hour," "The  
125 Untouchables," "December Bride,"  
126 "Willy," "Our Miss Brooks," "Make  
127 Room for Daddy," "Westinghouse De-  
128 silu Playhouse," "The Web" and shows  
129 starring Ray Bolger and George Gobel.  
130 Arnaz sold his Desilu interest to Miss  
131 Ball in 1963, three years after the  
132 couple divorced. He made a producing  
133 comeback in 1967 with "The Mothers-  
134 in-Law" television series and made  
135 scattered TV appearances in the 1970s.  
136 Miss Ball continued starring in her  
137 own weekly comedy series in the 1960s  
138 and early '70s. This fall she returned to  
139 television, in "Life with Lucy" on ABC.  
140 But the new series, which featured  
141 Lucy as a grandmother who is in  
142 partnership on a hardware store with  
143 her longtime foil Gale Gordon, was  
144 pulled by the network because of abys-  
145 mal ratings.  
146 Arnaz was born Desiderio Alberto  
147 Arnaz y de Acha III on March 2, 1917,  
148 in Santiago, Cuba, as the son of a  
149 politician-landowner. His family emi-  
150 grated to America after the 1933 Cuban  
151 revolution.  
152 At age 16 he enrolled in St. Patrick's  
153 High School, where his best friend was  
154 the son of Al Capone. At age 17, Arnaz  
155 sang in a Miami, Fla., band.  
156 He eventually came to Hollywood in  
157 the film version of the stage play "Too  
158 Many Girls," in which Miss Ball  
159 starred.  
160 According to "The Last Mafioso," a  
161 book by Aladena "Jimmy the Weasel"  
162 Fratianno, Mafia leader Sam "Mo Mo"  
163 Giancana ordered Arnaz killed because  
164 of bad publicity generated by Desilu's  
165 "Untouchables" TV series.  
166 Arnaz laughed it off in 1981 as "a  
167 bunch of bull."  
168 "I don't know how the hell they  
169 couldn't get me," he said. "I always  
170 drove to the studio myself, and I never  
171 had a bodyguard in my life."  
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
