

Rail Excursion Adds Dinner Service

GOWANDA — The New York and Lake Erie Railroad has announced the addition of diner service on its Satur-

day fall foliage excursion trains.

The Autumn Leaves Express is scheduled for Oct. 11 and 25 and will depart Gowanda at 10:30 a.m. Fares are \$15 for adults, \$8 for children ages 3-11, and free for children under 3. The schedule calls for a 60-mile round trip to Salamanca and a visit to the Salamanca Rail Museum. Return time is about 4:30 p.m.

The Railfan's Holiday is scheduled for Oct. 18 and will depart Gowanda at 9:30 a.m. Fares are \$20 for adults, \$13 for children ages 3-11 and free for

children under 3. Passengers will make a 90-mile round trip of the entire railroad line from the Conewango Valley to Salamanca. Return time is about 7 p.m.

The depot in Gowanda is at 50 Commercial St. The diner car is a former VIA Rail diner car. VIA Rail is the Canadian counterpart to Amtrack in the U.S.
